

CEO Report

I have issued 40 Land use permits to date . I have issued 25 plumbing permits. The burned building on Water street has been clean up and a new mobile home is being put on the Ripley road where the prior one burned.

The issue with the land lord on Zions Hill did not go as expected . I had to obtain a Administrative Inspection Warrant to inspect both properties. I did the inspection with a Maine State Fire Marshal and State Electrical Inspector. Both Buildings failed the inspection, I have sent a letter to the owner of the properties informing him what has to be corrected in both buildings and the time that he has to do it. I have made a number of trips around the lake and can find no violations.

I have had many people and contractors comment on the new date of November 1st for earth work around the lake, everyone is happy with the date.

I did a wellness inspection at a house on the North Dexter Road for the State (D.H.S.) along with The Chief Kevin Wintle , that inspection went very well.
