

CEMETERY REPORT JULY

- **We had 11 burials – 3 full body and 8 cremations.**
- **The crew worked 3 weeks mowing grass and trimming bushes along with the burials.**
- **They power washed headstones and markers and leveled stones the remaining week.**
- **Found and repaired 3 leaks in the water lines.**
- **Assisted the public looking for graves on numerous occasions.**
- **Worked with the Highway Department and Chuck Ellms hauling and leveling 1600yds of fill at the cemetery for the Vietnam moving wall.**
- **Gathered information on the cost and benefits of drilling a well in the cemetery and running new water lines in both the old and new cemetery.**
- **Met with Rick Whitney and Don Clukey from the Historical Society at Greene Cemetery to evaluate if there is a section that could accommodate new cremation burials. There are some residents that are requesting to be buried there.**
- **I went to Augusta to look at trucks at the State auction. I am still having trouble finding a ¾ ton, four door under \$7,000.**
