

Town Managers Report for October 2018 Council Meeting

Activities for the month of September

- Met with Consultants (Stantec) for Airport activities. They are working on an Obstruction Analysis and Environmental Assessment. Should be completed by summer of 2019. They also presented us with a Master Plan with a 20-year planning cycle. We will be setting up a meeting with the Airport Committee to discuss.
- Had two meetings with DOT on Rt 7 project. Progress reports and projects that need to be completed before winter shutdown.
- Attended a progress meeting with Library contractors. Completion dates are still the end of October.
- Been meeting with Recreation Committee on skating rink warming hut. Demolished old hut on September 28th and schedule for completion of new building is first week in December.
- Attended training on General Assistance and participated in an application. Still need some experience. Working with our GA administrator.
- Had meeting with Utility District on an upcoming upgrade for next year for sewer. Did have an issue with a small amount of sewage that went into Echo Lake. Issue has been taken care of.
- Met with Kevin Jordan about some upcoming projects and our Resource Officer. Planning on sending Officer to Academy with AOS 94 to pay for it.
- Working on safety program for Highway Department and have scheduled two consultations - one is a hearing assessment and the other a general audit.
- Completed Emergency Action update training for staff to come.
- Met with the Planning Board and discussed how we might approach Ordinances for the marijuana moratoriums. We need to establish an action plan and the Planning Board is waiting on council for direction.
- Met with Roof Systems of Maine on warranties and maintenance plans on roofs they have installed.
- Working on schedule of projects between the Parks and Recreation Department, Cemetery Crew, and Highway Department that need to be finished before winter arrives.
