Activities for the month of October

- Attended the Maine Municipal Association Conference October 3rd and 4th. Sessions attended included Reading Municipal Audit Reports, Senior Citizens and Property Taxes, The State of Maine's Economy, Walkable City, and State Agency Updates (Vital records, Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, Elections, Animal Welfare, and Liquor).
