Activities for the month Of November

- Attended the Maine Municipal Association Basic Municipal Budgeting
- Met with Kevin Jordan about resource officer attending Academy training and replacement officer during the Academy training.
- Helped schedule in work on wastewater piping issue with school and utility district. Project completed November 21st.
- Continued working on safety procedures for all departments.
- Attended meeting at First Universal Church to help with options on what to do with property. Meetings to Continue.
- Worked with New Town Clerk to fill Deputy Clerk position, reviewing and interviewing applicants. New hire to start December 17th, 2018.
- Attended Mid Maine Solid Waste Association's 2019 budget meeting representing town of Dexter. Assisted in safety consultation from Safety Works. Meet with Department of Environmental Protection to do walk around inspection of landfill and facility, discussed issues involving landfill life expectancy.
