

## Town Managers Report for March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2019 Council Meeting

### Activities for the month of February

- Facilitated two meetings with our Cannabis Task force, two presenters came in to discuss pros and cons of cannabis and marijuana.
- Met with Andrew Bermudez for updates on the work camp coming in July. Been in contact with the first group coming in March to do site evaluations.
- Attended a meeting with Dr. Reddy and School Administration about the future of Reddy Hospital. Working on a use plan for the building with school, working with fire chief to have fire marshal come and inspect to determine what we have for options.
- Awarded Stantec a five year contract for consultation work for ongoing and future Airport projects.
- Attended a meeting with Stantec and Airport committee to be updated on the Obstruction Analysis Plan and what the next steps are and what is involved.
- Met with Denise Buzelli from the Dover Foxcroft Chamber of Commerce to talk about how they could help promote Dexter and organize our events.
- Attended two DRC meetings discussing purpose and future of committee, and 2019 Hot Dog festival.
- Set up training procedures and met with highway department employees to do safety training in Bloodborne Pathogens, Hazardous Communication, Respiratory, Confined Space, and Lockout/Tagout.
- Finished compliance safety report on Public Works Dept. for Safety Works.
- Met with Representative Foster to talk about bills that may or may not benefit the town and its future. Also been discussing merger between Mayo Regional Hospital and Northern Lights Healthcare.
- Been meeting with and calling residents that are in the process of their homes going into foreclosure. Notifying and explaining ramifications if something wasn't done before deadlines.
- Attended two classes for meeting facilitation training through the University of Maine.
- Started working on spreadsheets for 2018/2019 town budget.
