Activities for the month Of May

- Continued working on 2019/20 budget with departments.
- Two meetings with Maine Earth and DOT to discuss issues with sidewalks, lights, crosswalks and concrete wall at police station and go over timeline for project completion.
- Updated businesses on Main Street to inform them about schedule of downtown construction.
- Met with biologist and discussed beaver issues in Mill Pond.
- Met with Hopkins Paving to discuss fall project (paving of Main Street Hill, Free Street and High Street) also discussed paving of exit and entry of municipal parking lots, sidewalk in front of Rand Hill.
- Met with Town manager of Newport and representative from Charter Communication to discuss franchise agreement.
- Facilitated public forum on allowing medical marijuana dispensaries in town. Discussed nonbinding questions that will be with the June ballots.
